Home Energy Assistance Program

Need help with heating costs? HEAP is a federally funded program that can provide financial assistance to help low income Ohioans with their utility bills.

Income Eligibility

<u>Household Size</u>	<u>Yearly Income</u>	<u>Monthly Income</u>
1 person	\$ 21,660/yr.	\$ 1,805/mo.
2 people	\$ 29,140/yr.	\$ 2,428/mo.
3 people	\$ 36,620/yr.	\$ 3,051/mo.
4 people	\$ 44,100/yr.	\$ 3,675/mo.

For households with more than 4 members, add \$7,480 annually per person.

For answers to questions, help with completing and mailing an application, or information on home weatherization and utility payment plans, contact or stop into the Council on Aging using the information below. In-home help is available for homebound seniors and younger disabled persons.
